

ANALISIS GENDER TERHADAP KEGIATAN PERIKANAN PANTAI: KASUS KABUPATEN SUBANG, JAWA BARAT

ABSTRACT

The Subang district is located in the north coast of Java Island. One of its economic sources is fisheries. Fifty percent of its production comes from sea. Women have multiple roles in fisheries activities, such as trader, fish-processor, and financial administrator, but their roles are not documented. This research is aimed (1) to analyze whether the Subang District coastal-fisheries activities have been gender responsive, and (2) to make a coastal-fisheries action plans which is gender responsive. The data analyses using Gender Analysis Pathway (GAP) and Moser Analysis. The results of research show that (1) coastal-fisheries activities of Subang District have not yet gender responsive, and (2) the action plans consist of capacity building, increasing education level, fostering community participation, improving local-based fisheries technology, and increasing employment opportunity.

ABSTRAK

Kabupaten Subang terletak di pantai utara Pulau Jawa. Salah satu sumber perekonomiannya adalah perikanan. Lima puluh persen dari produksinya berasal dari laut. Kaum perempuan mempunyai berbagai peran dalam kegiatan perikanan, seperti pedagang, pengolah ikan, dan pengelola keuangan, tetapi peran mereka tidak tercatat. Penelitian ini bertujuan untuk (1) menganalisis apakah kegiatan perikanan pantai di Kabupaten Subang sudah responsif gender, dan (2) untuk membuat rencana aksi perikanan pantai yang responsif gender. Data dianalisis menggunakan *Gender Analysis*
